The 2009 Lorser Feitelson and Helen Lundeberg Feitelson Arts Fellowship

**DEADLINE FOR ALL APPLICATION MATERIALS: January 23, 2009**

**GENERAL INFORMATION:** The Lorser Feitelson and Helen Lundeberg Feitelson Arts Fellowship is awarded through the Los Angeles Municipal Art Gallery Associates (LAMAGA), a nonprofit, tax-exempt organization that supports the Municipal Art Gallery at Barnsdall Park. The Feitelson Foundation award was conceived by the Feitelsons, seminal Los Angeles Modernist painters, and their friends, as a way to give encouragement to artists early in their careers by offering financial grants.

**JURORS:** Clara Kim, Director, Gallery at Redcat; Meg Linton, Director, Ben Maltz Gallery Otis College of Art and Design and Steve Turner, Steve Turner Contemporary.

**ELIGIBILITY:** The Feitelson Arts Fellowship award is granted to an individual who works in the following media: painting, photography, sculpture, printmaking, installation and/or new genre. Artists must live and work in Southern California. The 2009 Feitelson Fellowship is \$5,000 and the winner will be awarded a solo exhibition in the Project Room of the Los Angeles Art Municipal Gallery in conjunction with the C.O.L.A. mid-career artists' exhibition in May 14 – July 12, 2009. *Artists who have been awarded a Bachelor of Fine Arts or a Bachelor of Arts degree in art prior to June 1999 are not eligible. Applicants are not eligible if they have had solo museum exhibitions or had works purchased by a museum. The selection panel's decision will be final. Department of Cultural Affairs Employees are not eligible.*

A confirmation email will be sent to the applicant upon receipt of a completed application. All information will be held in strict confidence by LAMAGA.

## REQUIRED MATERIALS

**Artist's Statement:** Provide a description of your artistic goals, the nature of your work and how a financial grant would impact your pursuit of these goals (250 words maximum).

**Résumé:** Include a detailed résumé

**Images:** Submit a CD Rom containing twelve (12) images numbered 1 through 12 which best illustrates your work. Do not submit images of artwork that are more than five years old. Each image must be in JPEG format; *do not submit images as Tiffs, PDF, Word or PowerPoint files, or any other non-JPEG formats.*

Image files must not exceed 5 X 7 inches each, and should have a maximum image size of [504] pixels x [360] pixels each at 72 DPI. Be sure that each JPEG file is numbered sequentially (1 to 12) to correspond to your Image Annotation.

**Note:** New Genre artists may submit a DVD. The DVD must contain one preliminary reel no longer than 3 minutes, and may contain up to 10 minutes of additional viewing material. No other formats will be accepted for New Genre artists. Only New Genre artists may submit DVDs. All others must submit CD ROMs. Image Annotation: This document should include information about each submitted image (Numbered 1 through 12) including title, date, dimensions, media, and any additional information you feel is necessary to understanding the work.

**Letters of Recommendation:** Each artist seeking consideration for the Feitelson Arts Fellowship must also obtain two (2) letters of recommendation, sent under separate cover directly from each recommender. Letters should be written by individuals familiar with your artwork. Each letter of recommendation must include the name, address, contact phone number and email of the recommender.

These individuals may be contacted for expert evaluation of your work and professional standing. All comments to the Fellowship Committee are considered

confidential. Applications that do not have letters of recommendation will be deemed incomplete and ineligible.
